## Spiritual Disciplines

We're often told by health care specialists to develop a healthy diet and get plenty of exercise. We agree with them. We know they speak the truth. We can even see the results in those who do and those who don't. So why don't we do it? I would say it is a matter of motivation. If we're not motivated, we won't put our heart and soul into it.

We run into the same problem when it comes to growing a healthy spiritual life. We know it's important, but we lack the motivation. Romans 12:1 says, "Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship." In order for God to be glorified in us, we are to seek to do his will. Additionally, His grace should motivate us to it. When we reflect on God's grace, our thankfulness and humility will drive us to know Him more and do His will. Spiritual disciplines are the first step in developing the kind of lifestyle that is consistently bent towards appreciation for the grace of God.

These are the spiritual disciplines that are activities the individual Christian should embark upon in order to develop him/herself as a mature, Christ-like believer. These disciplines can be divided into two sub-categories:

Internal - Studying God's Word, Meditating, Memorizing God's Word, Prayer, and Fasting

External - Simplicity, Stewardship, Solitude, Submission, Service, and Evangelism

There also a few spiritual disciplines that are best practiced together with the body of believers. They are: Confession, Worship, Guidance, and Celebration.

A majority of our preaching in 2012 will focus on these spiritual disciplines. My prayer is that as we grow healthier and become *better* disciples, we will be more equipped and fit for God to use us to make *more* disciples for His glory!
