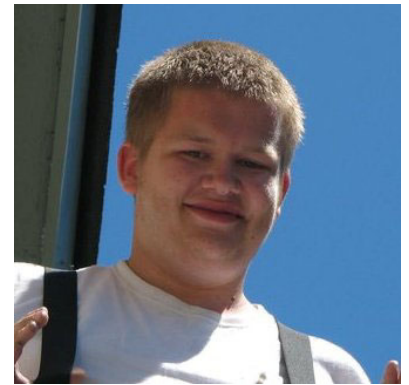

This past week I had the privilege of serving with some of the other churches in Salem. Youth Invasion was a program designed to take students from Salem and allow them to serve the community of Salem. They shared the love of Christ all week long. Tom Ewen, the youth minister from Grace Nazarene, came to all the other youth leaders in Salem with this idea. Many other communities have done this before and he thought it was time the students of Salem came together to serve as the Church. We all agreed and Youth Invasion sprang up from there!

In my group alone I had students from FCC Salem, Grace Nazarene, First Baptist, Mt. Vernon and Centralia. It was amazing to see God at work through junior high and high school students. They scraped paint, sanded, painted, trimmed, mowed, picked up trash, washed siding, picked up sticks and leaves, cleaned gutters, washed windows, visited nursing homes, baked cookies, built porches, steps and decks, and loved on complete strangers. The week was hot and humid and we were in a heat advisory almost every day of the week, but the students kept showing up excited to work. Some of the students asked if we could do this every week. They fell in love with the idea of serving and loving on people.

I wonder what would happen if all the followers of Christ in Salem would fall in love with that idea? I wonder what would happen if all the followers of Christ in Salem would take time out of their own lives and serve those who were in need. I don't mean for a few minutes on a Sunday morning. I'm talking about a Philippians 2 self sacrifice. What would happen if we all put others first and loved them the way God loves them? I would imagine more people would come to know who Christ really is if we did that. I would imagine our attitudes would have a permanent change. I would imagine that if we would exhale Christ through our service to others, God would be glorified. Let's take a lesson from our students and fall in love with service!

As most of you know, I participated in the One Way Singers and Orchestra Reunion concert this past weekend. Words can hardly express how wonderful a weekend it was. I owe a special thanks to John Mann for stepping in at the last minute to preach. Ely Lambert, who was slated to preach in my place, had a close friend die unexpectedly and needed to minister to that family.

If you don't know, the One Way Singers (OWS) was a community choir and orchestra sponsored by First Baptist Church in Salem. It consisted of around 60 high school and college students, and was led by Doyle Combs, who was Minister of Music at FBC and the Band Director at SCHS during the 70's. Over a period of ten years, the group traveled as far west as Carlsbad, New Mexico and as far north as Niagara Falls; from DC to New Orleans, and we even sang at Disney World. In addition to the tours, the group recorded four albums.

I learned just this week that the OWS was one of the (if not the first) pioneers in using live orchestration with a choir. I must admit that as a teenager I had no clue of the impact we were making in the Christian music industry (to be honest, none of us knew), nor did I fully comprehend what God was doing in us and through us. Now as I look back, I can see that we were indeed sowing seeds of the gospel in song and through our conduct. We don't know what trees God grew as a result of our ministry, and the fruit of those trees we may never see in this life. However, there is one thing I know – I know how it molded, shaped, and changed me.

Thank you, Doyle, and my OWS alumni. You have helped shape who I am today.
