GUEST MISSIONARY TO SPEAK TONIGHT @ 5:30

John Craycraft is no stranger to the chaplaincy. He was commissioned as a Navy chaplain in 1972. He was the first Navy chaplain endorsed by the Christian Churches and Churches of Christ. His assignments included base chapels, hospitals, destroyers, frigates, amphibious ships, a tender, submarines, and training centers. He had several operational jobs overseas. His career included five years with the Marines and two with the Coast Guard. After twenty-six years of active duty, he retired in 1998 with the grade of Captain (0-6).

On January 1, 2007 John Craycraft became the fourth Executive Director of the Chaplaincy Endorsement Commission, which is a mission supported by FCC.
