Sunday Mornings in the Children's Ministry

Beginning next Sunday, September 11th, the following classes will be available for your children:

⇒ Nursery = infants - 17 month olds. Staffed during 1st service, Sunday School, and 2nd service

⇒ Stepping Stones = 18 month olds - 3 year olds. Staffed during Sunday School and 2nd service. The nursery is available 1st service for these children who are not potty-trained and Building Blocks is available for these children who are potty-trained.

⇒ Building Blocks = potty-trained 3 year olds (by Sept 1st) - Preschoolers. Staffed during 1st service, Sunday School, and 2nd service.
